Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan Update

He advised that Buckinghamshire Council is fully committed to continuing to get the VALP through its examination and to adoption after which is will be a major part of the development plan for the Aylesbury Vale area until 2033. County-wide work is also going to commence on a new local plan for Buckinghamshire looking to 2050 as there needs to be a plan in place within five years.
